Assessment Literacy: Using Assessment Information to Make Sound Decisions

Assessment underpins every decision that is made in a classroom regarding student learning. This requires that the classroom teacher knows how to collect and interpret quality data, from daily classroom assessment to yearly-standardized tests, in order to make sound decisions about student learning.

It also requires that the teacher knows how to involve the students in the use of

quality assessment information since the student is the one who has to make the leap from where he is to where he wants to be next in his learning. Current technology that is available to both teachers and students can help them in the collection and interpretation of student achievement data.

To support the implementation of quality assessment practices in every classroom, the system needs to support the educators in their pursuit of assessment literacy. In addition, the teachers need the support of competent leaders as they implement these practices in their classrooms
