Doug Fisher is a professor of language and literacy education in the department of teacher education at San Diego State University, as well as and a classroom teacher at Health Sciences High & Middle College. Fisher has authored numerous publications on literacy, differentiated instruction, and curriculum design, and has coauthored several books, including *Checking for Understanding: Formative Assessments for Your Classroom*, and *The Formative Assessment Action Plan*.

Designed to be an interactive experience, this session will allow for expert modeling of key content by the presenter, and multiple ways for participants to engage with Doug Fisher, the content, and each other throughout the session.

- Checking for understanding to ensure quality thinking
