Doug Fisher is a professor of language and literacy education in the department of teacher education at San Diego State University, as well as and a classroom teacher at Health Sciences High & Middle College. Fisher has authored numerous publications on literacy, differentiated instruction, and curriculum design, and has coauthored several books, including Checking for Understanding: Formative Assessments for Your Classroom, and The Formative Assessment Action Plan.
