Algebra as a Civil Right

In his young adult life, Dr. Moses was a pivotal organizer for the civil rights movement. Today, Dr. Moses serves as the founder and president of the Algebra Project Inc., which he began while pursuing his doctorate of Philosophy at Harvard University.
